

# Daily Prayer

Every school day begins with the morning prayer over the PA system. These prayers reflect the readings of the day, a celebration of the feast day of a saint, or a special event in the life of the Church or the school community. Each morning a member of a selected team of students reads the morning prayer aloud to the community.

The school day ends with community-wide prayer as well. At the end of the 7th period every day, a student reads the ***Examen Prayer*** of St. Ignatius Loyola over the PA system. The entire school quiets. Faculty and students participate in a daily “Examen” where one can grow more sensitive to their own spirit and become more open to receive the support God offers by reflecting on their day.
