Mission Statement

St. John's Jesuit develops Christian leaders. As a Catholic school in the Jesuit tradition, we inspire each student to achieve his greatest potential in a diverse, Christ-centered atmosphere distinguished by academic success and service as a man for others.

ST. JOHN'S JESUIT HIGH SCHOOL WAS FOUNDED IN 1868 and re-established in 1965 as a four-year, college preparatory high school for young men. In 2004, St. John's Jesuit established the Academy for seventh and eighth grade students, and in 2011, a sixth grade was added to the Academy. The school currently has an enrollment of 726 students, with 567 students attending the High School and 159 attending the Academy. Our students come from all socioeconomic backgrounds. Our student body is diverse, including 12% African American, 4% Asian, 5% Hispanic, and 5% multi-racial. St. John's Jesuit is a Catholic school; however, religious diversity is also present.

The Class of 2020

The Class of 2020 has 134 students. Acceptance to St. John's Jesuit is based upon criteria that includes admission placement test results, elementary and junior high school academic performance, and the recommendations of elementary and junior high teachers, counselors and principals.

The Magis Society

The Magis Society is a selective program designed to invoke students' interest, passions, and talents. It begins with a rigorous application process before the freshman year and provides a four year framework consisting of curricular and enrichment experiences. A student's career in the Magis Society culminates in a personal Capstone Project which involves a tangible experience, a dissertation, a presentation, and an oral defense.

SJJ Faculty

St. John's Jesuit High School & Academy has 56 faculty and administrative members who hold 4 doctorate degrees, 27 Master's degrees, and 25 Bachelor's degrees. The student to faculty/administrative ratio is 13:1.

Grade Point Average

A student's GPA is calculated based upon all courses taken in high school, excluding physical education and the ACT prep course. The academic year is comprised of two semesters.

- Students are admitted selectively.
- Students are not ranked.
- Advanced Placement and Honors courses require teacher approval based on stringent requirements and are weighted (AP = 1.0 Honors = .5 with a C or better).
- Approximately 98% of all St. John's Jesuit graduates continue their secondary education at colleges and universities.
- St. John's Jesuit does not report disciplinary history on either the transcript, or on the Secondary School Report.
- Christian Service is part of the curriculum, with 10 hours of service required for freshmen; 15 hours required for sophomores; and 20 hours required for juniors. Students choose from national and international experiences.
- In order to graduate, every student must complete a 2-week Senior Project that is career-related or is a volunteer field experience under the direction of a faculty advisor. Seniors must produce an in-depth report from their experience and defend it to a committee of faculty and alumni for final review and approval.

St. John's Jesuit is accredited by the State of Ohio, the Ohio Catholic Schools Accrediting Association, the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, and the Jesuit Schools Network. As a college-preparatory school, the curriculum prepares students for success in college.
